Since health is part of our values, we believe that it is very important to respect the environment. We work to minimize our ecological footprint. The concern of revaluation of the matter is always omnipresent from the conception to the manufacture of our products.

The selected or jointed wood grade components manufactured at Interbois are free of VOC emissions since the glue used is formaldehyde-free.

We use the lowest grade of wood available at the mills for the manufacturing of our jointed components, and we also unite the clear portions into a value-added wood.

We also believe in the optimization of used wood materials which includes the reuse of wood residues or chips. Any unusable wood is milled and sold in the form of mulch, plant cover or animal bedding.

When manufacturing our primer or dye products, there is unfortunately a very low VOC emission. Environmental standards require not to exceed 15kg / day and since the products we use are water based, we are well below the prescribed standard.

Our MDF moldings and components are made from recycled wood fiber. We also verify that recycled fiberboards meet the requirements of our Canadian suppliers.

We also work with our various suppliers so that together we can do our part to respect the environment. We take care to minimize the impacts on the environment throughout all our manufacturing processes; it's starts when our wood supply comes in until our products are delivered out by our truck.
